Golf Course Attire

Please use good judgment when dressing for the Golf Course. It is mandatory for any golfer playing on our course to have spikeless golf shoes or to have soft spikes (or an equivalent) in their golf shoes. All golfers must wear appropriate attire to be determined by the Golf Professional.

Examples include: **Appropriate Attire:** collared or mock neck shirts, golf slacks, Bermuda shorts, and golf shorts.

Inappropriate Attire: Halter-tops, blue jeans, tennis shorts, gym trunks, tank tops, t-shirts, short-shorts, racquetball shorts, boxer type shorts, and sweat pants.



THE GOLF COURSE

COURSE AVAILABILITY

The golf course is open year round, but may be closed due to weather conditions or during scheduled golf events. Dates for such events are posted outside of the Golf Shop and in your monthly newsletter. Please also refer to your monthly calendar in the newsletter for closings due to private golf parties. Tee times are encouraged at all times in order to avoid disappointment

Greensburg Country Club is an original member of the Tri-County Golf Association. This organization consists of private clubs in the area that allow reciprocity among its member clubs for full golfing members.

GOLF CARTS

Golf carts are the property of Greensburg Country Club and are provided by the Golf Shop to adult members and guests with a valid driver's license. Members and their guests who choose to operate a golf cart assume the responsibility and liability for its safe operation. Parents of children who are eligible and choose to operate a golf cart assume responsibility for their operation.

The Grounds Superintendent and Golf Professional will determine whether carts can be operated on the course or when they shall be run only on cart paths and in the fairways. Carts must be kept a minimum of 15 yards away from tees and greens

Guest Policy

Local guests are limited to two times per month and six times per calendar year. On weekends and holidays members bringing more than one guest may not tee off **before 10:30**. Charges incurred by guests and will be billed to the member's account or payable by cash or credit card. Additional details may be obtained from the Golf Professional

GOLF SHOP CHECK IN / OUT

Please ensure you check in with the Pro Shop before beginning your round to confirm whether you will be playing 9 or 18 holes.

This allows us to effectively manage tee times, bill correctly and maintain an optimal pace of play for all members and guests. We appreciate your attention to this matter.

WALKING THE COURSE

Members are permitted to walk the golf course and carry their own bags after 5:00 p.m., but walking members must allow faster players to play through. Pull carts are not allowed on the golf course



GOLF LESSONS

Private lessons are available with our professional golf staff. Please call the Golf Shop to schedule your lesson. Clinics and playing lessons are also available. Please call Golf Shop to schedule.



PLAYING IN GROUPS OF FIVE OR MORE

Groups of more than four are discouraged from Memorial Day through Labor Day. All golf groupings larger than four must receive approval from the Golf Professional prior to commencing their round. The Golf Professional has complete discretion whether groupings larger than four will be permitted. Groupings of more than four are expected to allow faster groups of any size playing behind them to play through

PROPERTY DAMAGE POLICY

It has always been and remains the Club's policy that an individual who causes injury or damage to another person while playing or practicing is solely responsible for that injury or damage. We ask that any member or guest whose golf ball strikes a person, automobile, personal property, or home while playing at the Club make every effort to provide the Club Office with a name and telephone number so that the responsible party can be contacted. Usually, an individual's homeowner's insurance policy will cover unintentional injury or damage to another person or their property. Greensburg Country Club assumes no liability in such cases. Two of the course's golf holes cross public roads. If at any time a player feels that they cannot execute a shot safely, it is the player's responsibility to pick up their ball and move it to a place where the shot can be hit safely.

COURSE ETIQUETTE

Courtesy and consideration of others is the foundation of golf procedures and is the basis for enjoying a good round of golf for all players. All players are to be familiar with Rules and Etiquette of Golf and observe such rules at all times. If there is an open hole ahead of you, you are expected to let faster groups behind you play through. Players, including guests, are expected to do their part in keeping the course in good condition by replacing fairway divots then filling with sand provided, repairing ball marks on the greens, raking traps, and preventing littering

ARRANGING A GOLF GAME

If you want to play a round of golf, but do not have a foursome, contact the Golf Shop, who may be able to connect you with others looking for a game. Saturdays and Sundays at 9:00 and 9:10 a.m. during the summer will be a pro's time for golfers that need a game. Please call the Golf Shop to be included. Additional times will be added on an as-needed basis. Also, there are planned golf events for men, women, and couples, which will have individual sign-ups and do not require prearranged foursomes.

LOCKER ROOM

All golf members should meet the Locker Room attendants to receive a locker assignment.

Please check with our Locker Room attendants concerning the numerous special locker room services.

Custom dictates that Locker Room attendants who perform uniquely personal, optional services (i.e.: shoe shines) receive tips.

To choose a locker in either Men's or Women's locker rooms, please contact the locker room staff & office.

LOST OR STOLEN PROPERTY

Greensburg Country Club is not responsible for lost or stolen items on club property. Lockers are available in the pool and clubhouse locker rooms

Junior Golf

Greensburg Country Club's Junior Golf Program is open to children ages seven through eighteen whose parents or grandparents have a GCC membership. Non-golf member juniors are permitted to golf on Junior Golf day ONLY. Juniors who are grandchildren of golf members are permitted to play golf on other days if accompanied by grandparent. Starting with the first Tuesday in June through the third Tuesday in August, #1 tee will be closed from 8:30 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. for the Junior Golf Program. Play will be permitted before 8:30 a.m. but tee times are limited and mandatory.

OUTSIDE FOOD AND BEVERAGES

**PROHIBITED
(PRIVATE & DAILY EVENTS)**

The entire course, parking lot and all buildings are regulated by the PLCB. PLCB regulations prohibit the use of outside coolers. All Food and Beverages consumed on the Club premises must be purchased at the Club



Junior Golf Attire

Proper attire is mandatory on Junior Golf day and for all visits to the golf course and driving range. Jeans and t-shirts are not appropriate.

PRACTICE AREAS

The Practice Range is limited to Golf members and their guests. Please observe posted rules of usage and check at the Golf Shop for hours of operation. Range balls are available in the Golf Shop. Practice areas are open to golfing members and golfing guests. Only golfing members and golfing guests are permitted to use the Practice Putting Green. At no time is practice permitted on the golf course. Generally during the golf season, the practice area is open ½ hour before starting tee times and closes at 6:30 p.m. The range will close at 5:30 p.m. on Sundays. Target flags are located on the range. Practice shots should only be directed at the target flags. There is a residential area to the left of the range. Members and guests utilizing the practice area are responsible for damage to persons or property.

THE CLUBHOUSE AND DINING ROOM

MEMBER RESPONSIBILITY

Members are responsible for the conduct and actions of themselves, their families and their guests. Children ages twelve (12) and under must be accompanied by an adult in the dining area.

Enjoy a meal after your game on our covered side patio or inside The Grille Room. Patio is open seasonally.

FAMILY MEMBERSHIPS

FAMILY MEMBERS SHALL HAVE ALL PRIVILEGES OF THEIR CHOSEN MEMBERSHIP FOR ALL MEMBERS OF THE FAMILY UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE AND LIVING IN THE MEMBER'S HOUSEHOLD OR ANY CHILD UNDER 25 YEARS OF AGE AND A FULL-TIME STUDENT LIVING IN THE MEMBER'S HOUSEHOLD OR ANY CHILD UNDER 25 YEARS OF AGE ON ACTIVE DUTY IN THE MILITARY.

YOU MAY ALSO INCLUDE GRANDCHILDREN UNDER THE AGE 12.

ALCOHOL POLICY

The Club will comply with all federal, state and local laws pertaining to the sale and service of alcoholic beverages. Alcoholic beverages will be sold and served on the club premises during hours specified by the law. Members and guests are not permitted to bring alcoholic beverages onto club property. All alcoholic beverages must be purchased from the club.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Dinner reservations are recommended for your dining enjoyment. Reservations can be made by calling the Clubhouse at (724) 837-1810. Hours for Club dining areas vary each month and are published in the newsletter and in the weekly email. Changes to dining hours may be made at any time and will be communicated to the membership, but to avoid disappointment, we recommend calling ahead

PRIVATE PARTIES AND BANQUETS

The Club is a great place to host events such as wedding receptions, showers, golf outings, holiday parties and business meetings. Please call our Event Coordinator Debbie Pologruto at (724) 837-1810 ext. 133 to schedule and plan your special event.

SOCIAL EVENTS

The Club hosts numerous parties and holiday events throughout the year. You can celebrate Easter, Mother's Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, and Labor Day at the Club. Valet Parking

VALET PARKING IS PROVIDED AS A CONVENIENCE TO OUR MEMBERS AND GUESTS. VALET PARKING IS AT YOUR OWN RISK. MEMBERS AND GUESTS THAT WISH TO PARK THEIR OWN VEHICLE MAY DO SO BUT ONLY IN THE PAVED PARKING AREAS BELOW THE CABANA. MEMBERS MAY NOT SELF-PARK IN THE GRASS OVERFLOW PARKING AREA. CARS SHOULD NEVER BE PARKED IN FIRE LANES, DELIVERY AREAS, OR ON FRONT DRIVEWAY. THERE CAN BE ABSOLUTELY NO PARKING BEHIND THE CLUBHOUSE.

VALET LIABILITY

All vehicles are parked at owner's risk. No liability is assumed by Greensburg Country Club for loss or damage by fire, theft, or any other cause to, or by the vehicle while in custody of Greensburg Country Club. All claims must be presented before vehicle is taken from facility. Any person driving becomes the agent of the owner solely. We are not responsible for articles left in vehicle or mechanical problems. - 16

DINING ETIQUETTE

- We kindly ask that children be mindful of other members and guests while dining. Excessive noise, running, or disruptive behavior is not permitted in the dining areas.
- If a child becomes disruptive, the parent or guardian will be asked to escort the child out of the dining area until the behavior is resolved.

DRESS CODE FOR DINING

- Unless a specific event requires more formal attire, the general dress code for Clubhouse dining areas is Country Club Casual. Proper golf attire is permitted as well as more formal attire. Tailored shirts designed to be worn untucked and dress denim are specifically included as Country Club Casual. T-shirts and swimwear are not permitted. Men's hats should be removed upon entering the upstairs dining areas but may be worn in the Members Grille Room if worn appropriately. Shoes must be worn at all times in the Clubhouse except for locker room areas.

CELL PHONE POLICY

We recognize that cell phones enable many of our members to take advantage of our Club while still staying connected to the outside world. While cell phone use is not prohibited, we do ask that, out of respect for your fellow members, you put your phone on silent or vibrate while in the Clubhouse or on the golf course and that you excuse yourself from our dining rooms when you need to place or receive a call.





THE POOL AND CABANA

Swimming Greensburg Country Club's pool is a very fun and active place for the family. The outdoor swim facility provides diving areas, a children's pool, a snack bar, dressing area and plenty of room for poolside sunbathing. Access to the Pool and Cabana is limited to those members with pool privileges.

POOL HOURS (WEATHER PERMITTING)

Pool Hours (weather permitting) Specific Pool Hours will be posted at the pool and may vary. The pool and cabana will generally be open every day from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day. Please call the Clubhouse for information related to weather related closings or delays. In the event of inclement or cold weather, Management may close the pool for part or all of the day. In the case of a sudden storm, the lifeguards may immediately close the pool for the duration of the storm. The pool will close early on the days of "home" swim meets or club events and may close at other times for club events.



Swim Attire

SWIM ATTIRE INDIVIDUALS IN SWIM ATTIRE ARE NOT PERMITTED OUTSIDE THE POOL AREA. SWIMMERS MUST BE PROPERLY ATTIRE TO USE THE CLUBHOUSE. SWIMMERS AND SUNBATHERS MUST WEAR REGULATION SWIMSUITS - NO CUTOFFS PERMITTED

BABYSITTERS

Babysitters are permitted to accompany children under 12 years of age without paying a guest fee. The babysitter must register in the daily log. Babysitters must be at least sixteen (16) years of age to accompany children at the pool without a parent. Babysitters for children 12 years of age and older will be charged a guest fee. To avoid confusion, no Greensburg Country Club Pool or Cabana employee may be designated as a private babysitter at the pool.

HOUSE GUEST PASSES

House Guests Members who have visiting temporary houseguests (friends, family, etc.) may purchase pool passes for them at the rates below.

Members will be responsible for all charges made by their houseguests.

Individual Weekly Pass --- \$70.00

Family Weekly Pass --- \$175.00

MEMBERS & GUEST

- ALL Pool Members and Guest are to sign in at the Cabana station before entering the Pool area.
- Members may purchase a daily pass for their guests for a \$10 fee for each individual or \$25.00 for a family. Guests, other than houseguests, are limited to two times per month or six times per year

Charging and Cash Policy



RECIPROCAL BILLING

Greensburg Country Club does not have pre-arranged individual charging privileges with any other country clubs. Please check with the Club Office when visiting another country club if charging privileges are required. Charging privileges may be extended for specific groups, outings, or events.

All members are required to be signed up for one of three options for charges incurred at the club. Monthly ACH Debit: A voided check must be on file at the Club. By providing a checking account from which funds may be withdrawn, you will be permitted full charging privileges at the Club. A monthly invoice will be sent to you on the **First** of every month. If not paid by the **Tenth** of each month, your account will be debited for the amount of the invoice. Any children listed on your application will have charging privileges on your account. Monthly Credit Card Charge: Your credit card information will be kept on file at the Club. You will receive monthly invoices and, if not paid by the **Tenth** of the month, this amount will be charged to the credit card kept on file. Accordingly, you will be permitted full charging privileges throughout the Club. Any children listed on your application will have charging privileges on your account. Cash, check or credit card deposit: By depositing a minimum of \$1,000 with the Club, you will be permitted full charging privileges. If a credit card is used, it must be presented in person at the time of deposit. Any charges incurred will be deducted from your deposit. A monthly invoice will be sent to you with your current balance. You will be expected to pay any amount necessary to bring your account balance back to \$0. Any children listed on your application will have charging privileges on your account. Members also have the ability to pay their bill online between the 1st of the month to the 9th of the month. Online bill pay is available at www.greensburgcountryclub.golf on the Member login page or App. You may always pay with cash or credit card at the time of purchase, regardless of which Member Billing option you choose.
